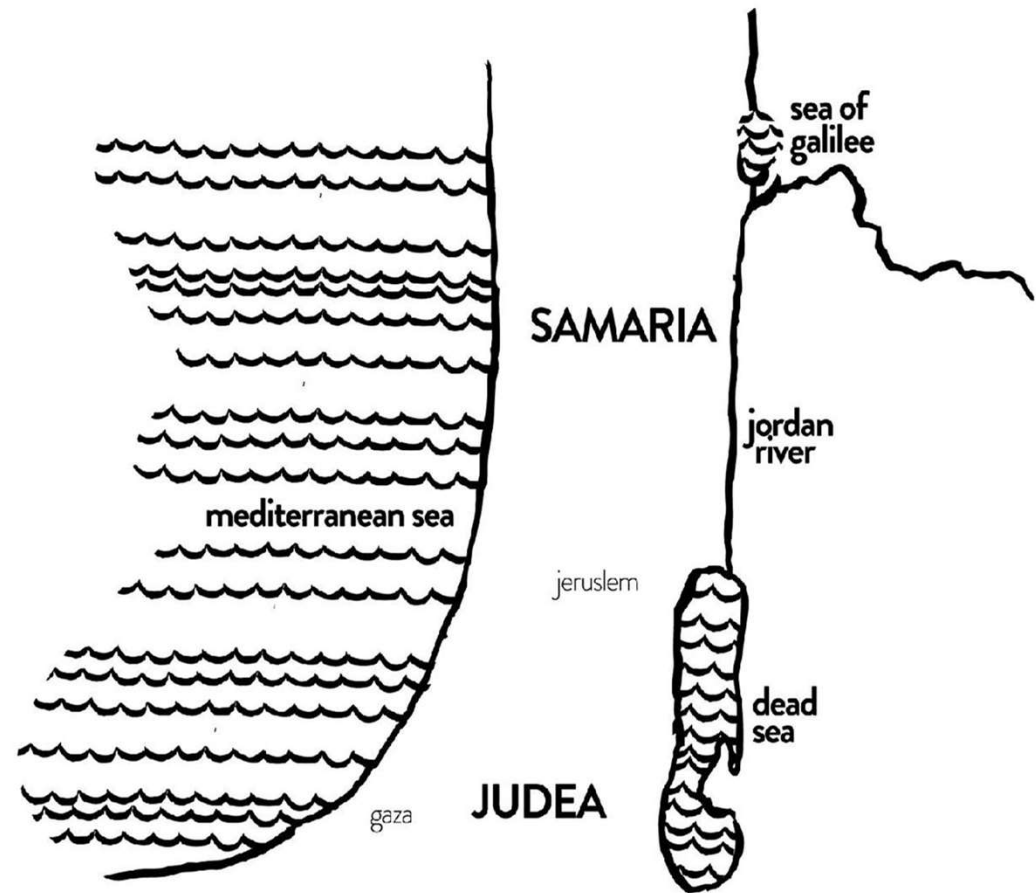
Acts 1:8

On that day a great persecution broke out against the church in **Jerusalem**, and all except the apostles were scattered throughout **Judea** and **Samaria**.

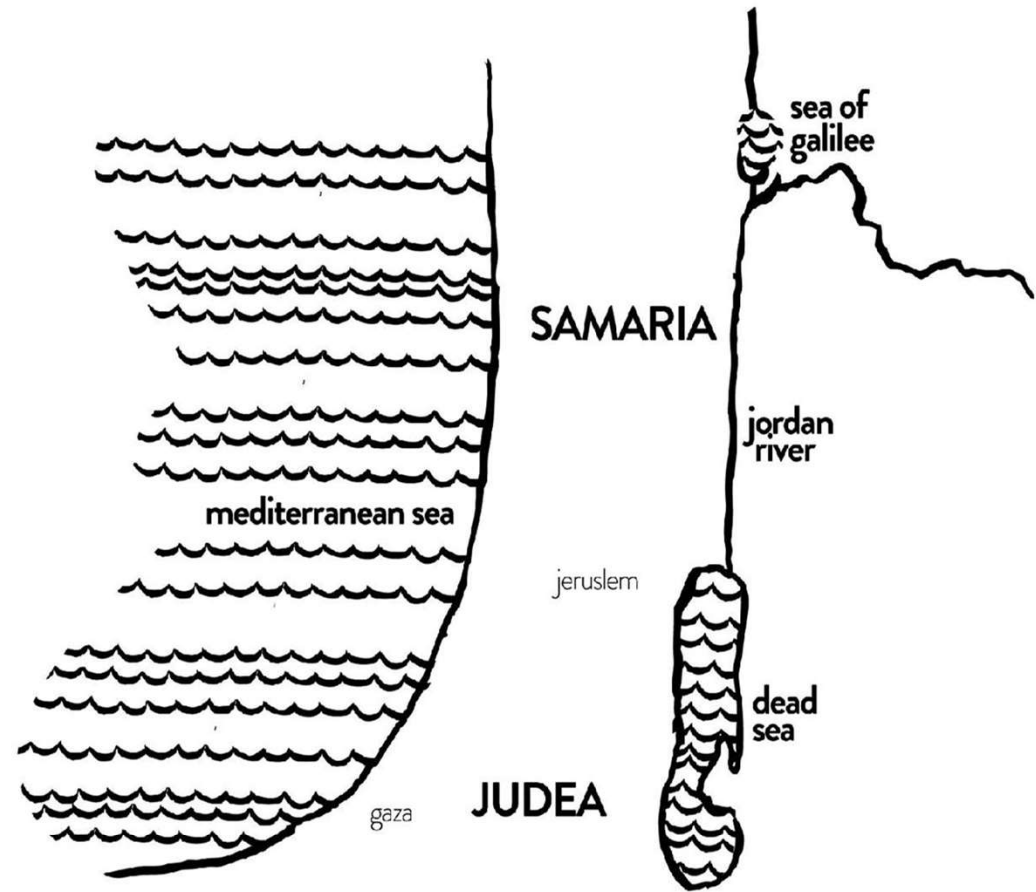
⁴ Those who had been scattered preached the word wherever they went.

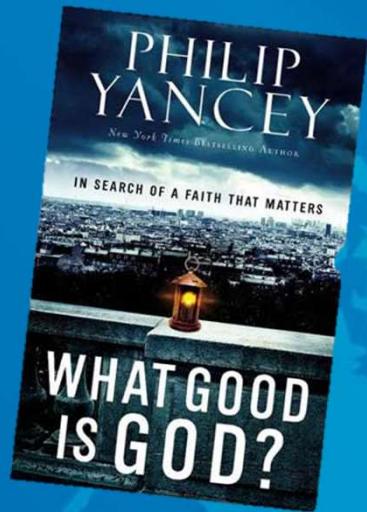






“These guys are monsters-rapists, murderers. And from what I see you were simply holding Bible studies, playing trust games and having prayer meetings.

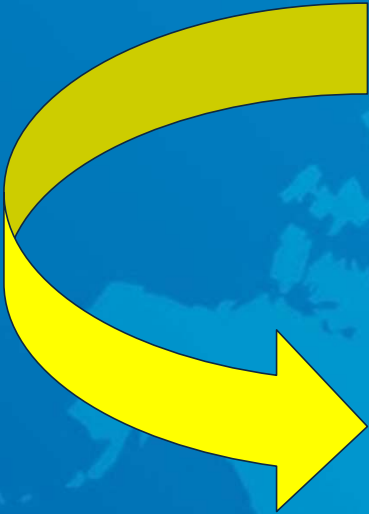
³⁰ Then Philip ran up to the chariot and heard the man reading Isaiah the prophet. “Do you understand what you are reading?” Philip asked.

³⁵ Then Philip began with that very passage of Scripture and told him the good news about Jesus.



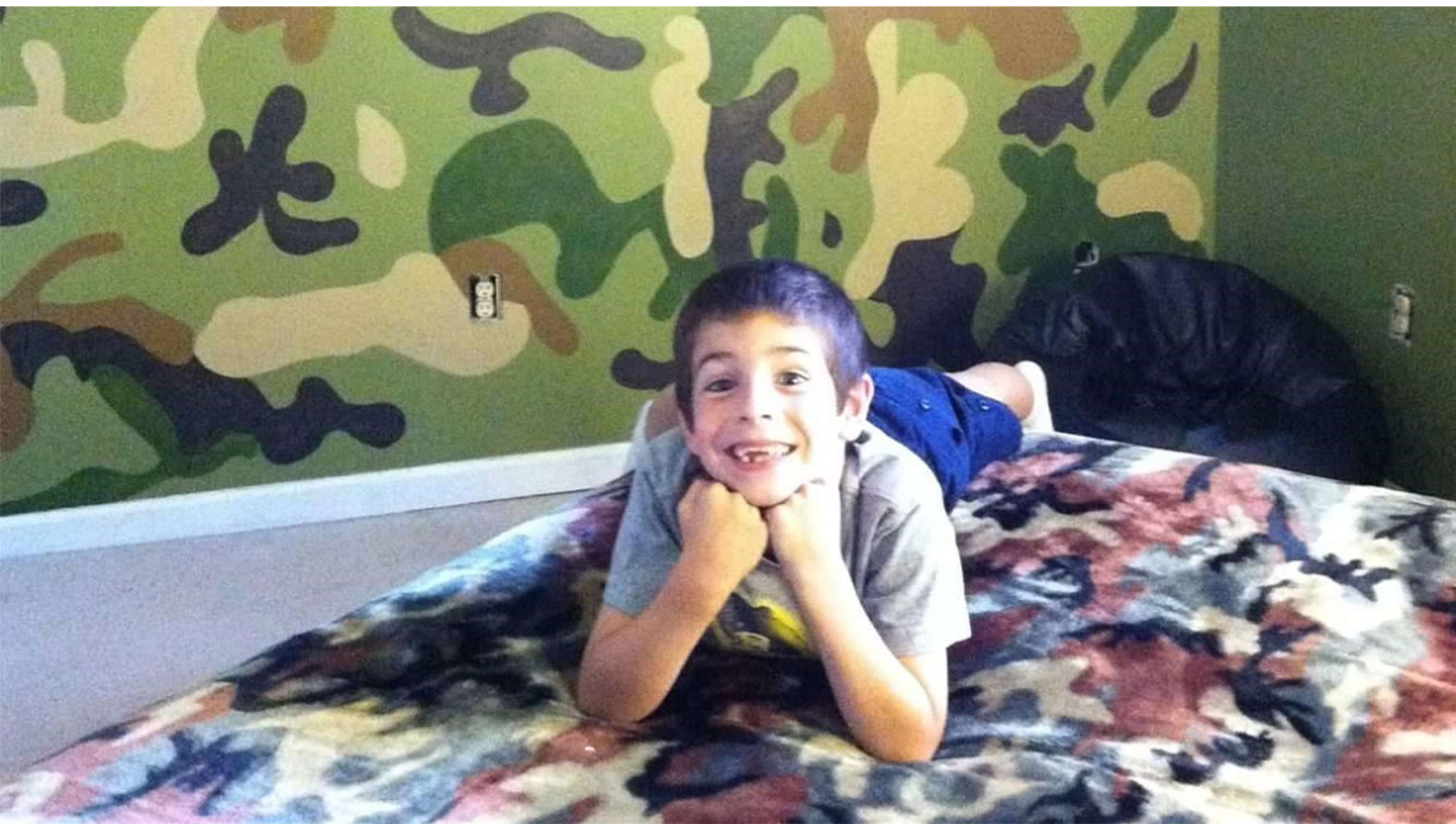
